New Jersey Child Care Subsidy Programs

REDUCTION IN CO-PAYMENTS EFFECTIVE MARCH 2020

If you serve families enrolled in New Jersey's Department of Human Services, Division of Family Development (DHS/DFD), Child Care Subsidy Program, as of March 2020, families will see a reduction in their copay amount. Therefore, although the payment you receive from parents will be less, the payment you receive from the state will increase to cover that cost.

These changes are scheduled to go into effect March 2020 and will be reflected in your March 31st direct deposit. As of March 2020, families will begin paying providers the reduced copay amount for the remaining period within their current Parent/Applicant Provider Agreement (PAPA).

Letters were mailed to providers, parents to inform about the changes.
